Attached you will find an application for the Central California Art Association & Mistlin Gallery Art Scholar Program for 2023. These classes are offered to junior high and high school students who will benefit from extended art instruction in a professional environment. Teachers, counselors, and referring agencies:

Please recommend students who are "at risk" and in danger of falling between the cracks, economically disadvantaged, foster, or in need of direction to help them make a difference in their lives. The students that you recommend are **expected to make a commitment to attend all sessions and to participate fully in the program.** We ask that you discuss the level of commitment required in this program with prospective applicants. Because of limited space we want to ensure that all those accepted will take full advantage of the opportunity. **In addition to participating in all 10 meetings, students will be expected to present and prepare an exhibition of their work, which will be accompanied by a formal reception.** Teaching artists who have an excellent rapport with youth will facilitate the classes. There will be ten classes plus the exhibit and reception. Students will be supplied with materials. In addition, fully participating students will be given a parting gift of materials for continuing with their art practice on their own. The program is limited to 12 students, with priority given to high school students and those who have not participated in the past.

Spring 2023 Session open to students grades 7-12 (no exceptions).
