



## Proposal Submissions

### Creative Synergy

By the time you are ready to submit your proposals you should have your group together and working on a cohesive theme for your project. Getting ready for this proposal is a great way to flesh out your ideas with your artistic teammates. Each group should select a point person to head the video proposal production.

What should be included in your proposal?

1. Introduce your collaborators (Who have you chosen to group up with and what do they specialize in?)
2. What theme have you chosen to work with as a group?
3. How does each collaborator intend to use their specialty to bring this project together?
4. Is there any work in development from the visual artist that can be shared at this time or any works in progress to help us understand the vision of your proposal?
5. How will the work be displayed in the gallery?
  - size of visual art/ medium
  - poetry accompanying it/ short story or writing (how will it be printed/ presented)
  - QR codes for music, dance, or stage performances (The amount of work dedicated to the final video submissions is up to those submitting them. The final product for this should be submitted via a QR code which will be printed and hung next to the visual art. There will also be opportunities for some live performances during the two art walks that will be hosted during this exhibition- please contact the Gallery Coordinator, Krystle Lisek, if you would like to schedule a live performance in addition to the QR code submission)

Please try to keep your proposals to 15 minutes or less. Once all the proposals have been received the committee will begin reviewing the videos. Notifications of acceptance will be sent via email no later than March 25, 2023. The submission fees will be collected during the show receiving on July 16, 2023.
