“TRASH TO TREASURES:” Upcycled & Repurposed Art
May 9 – June 10, 2023

Show Hosts: Karen Kingsbury & Krystle Lisek

This show, open to all artists, will be on exhibit at the Mistlin Gallery during the month of May. The theme of “Trash to Treasure” calls for artists to create art from discarded, unwanted, or disposable items. The resulting artwork can include wall hangings, sculptures, fabric art, and small furniture pieces. All media will be accepted. Stretch your imagination and have fun. The reception and prize awards will happen during the Third Thursday Art Walk on May 18th.

Awards: Monetary prizes and ribbons will be awarded for Best of Show (\$100). First Place (\$100), Second Place (\$75), and Third Place (\$50). Honorable Mention will be awarded a ribbon. The People’s Choice award will be announced at the Art Walk.

Jurors and Judges: All art will be juried by the show hosts. Awards will not be given by categories. The guest judges will be announced at a later date. Show hosts may be contacted via email with any questions about artwork viability before submission.

Fees and Number of Entries: Each artist may submit up to 4 entries at \$20 per entry for non-members and \$15 per entry for CCAA members. Entry Fees are non-refundable. Accepted entries that exceed 160 inches including the frame will be charged an additional \$10 handling fee at the time of drop-off. Furniture pieces can include small tables, chairs, etc.

Entry Start Date: February 1, 2023

Entry Deadline: April 23, by 5 p.m.

Notification of acceptance will be via email sent by April 28.

Receiving will be at the Mistlin Gallery 1015 J St. Modesto, CA on:

May 7, 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. No mail-in entries will be accepted.

Show closes on June 10.

Artwork must be picked up on June 11 between 11am - 3pm.

Note: All artwork must be original and representative of the show’s theme. Any work shown at the Mistlin Gallery within the last one year is not eligible. Wall art must be ready to hang. Artists will be required to sign a Waiver of Loss or Damage at the time of delivery. The gallery requires a 40% commission on each piece sold, so price your work accordingly.

Terms: The gallery reserves the right to not accept art that differs significantly from the submitted image and/or is not properly prepared for installation. Entering this competition

indicates agreement that images may be used for promoting the show.
